To whom it may concern,

We would like to help the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services locate deadbeat Dad Neal Rauhauser so that he can finally be held accountable for being **THIRTEEN YEARS BEHIND** on child support payments. Mr. Rauhauser, who currently has **four outstanding warrants for his arrest**, owes approximately \$59,000 to his ex-wife, Nancy Nogg.

Because of the flagrant disregard Mr. Rauhauser has displayed for his obligations to his children we would hope that, as an Officer-of-the-Court, Mr. Dorrell's sense of duty and honor to enforce the law will make him feel it's incumbent upon him to accept any paperwork which Nebraska DHHS needs to serve on Mr. Rauhauser.

We will be releasing a nationwide press release shortly to ensure that this issue receives the proper attention that it deserves. We are hopeful that DHHS will do everything in its power to finally get justice for Nancy Nogg (who has bravely survived two bouts of cancer) and her two children. We are admittedly baffled that the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services would allow this injustice to drag on for **THIRTEEN YEARS**.

Bullyville has ongoing litigation in Tarrant County, Texas involving Mr. Rauhauser and it is our plan to depose him in that case once it is calendared. Additionally, we will notify Nebraska DHHS, along with a few other agencies, of that date so that in the event that they are still unable to locate Rauhauser's whereabouts by that court appearance, a legal representative of Nebraska DHHS can be on the premises to properly serve him.
