According to the United States Attorney, the University of Central Missouri, and my Co-defendant, together with several agencies of the United States, I knew that my co-defendant created a computer virus that enabled him -if he were successful- to change grades, steal money and view faculty only areas of the University of Central Missouri computer systems.

According to these same individuals, no damage was actually done to any of the systems. That is to say, that this was only attempted.

I was convicted of Count One: (Conspiracy) with all other counts (2 - 7) dismissed upon a motion of the government.

My co-defendant was convicted of Count One and Count Two (Computer Intrusion Causing Damage) however he has not been sentenced, nor is it anticipated that he will serve any time in prison since he agreed pursuant to 5k1.1 of the Sentencing Guidelines to provide "substantial assistance" to the government -dispite his being much more culpable in the offense, by his own and the governments admission.
